Greetings!

The Emerging Farmers Conference is a two-day event that serves to advance the success and sustainability of farmers who traditionally face barriers to building agricultural businesses. The conference focuses primarily on the education, needs, and interests of immigrant farmers and farmers of color. Sessions are interpreted into over nine languages, and are led primarily by farmers themselves. The EFC is hosted by a collaborative of local and statewide organizations that are run by and/or work with farmers of color. Listening to Farmer Voices

The Emerging Farmers Conference is intentionally working towards a future of empowered farmers. As a starting point, we held a small event last fall, ReRooting the Emerging Farmers Conference. It was a day filled with conversation, reflection, and ideation surrounding the annual conference. We brought nearly 50 farmers and sponsors together at the in-person event, and received survey feedback from another 45 farmers. Major findings include the need for greater conference outreach; an even stronger farmer voice at the event; additional opportunities for farmer network building; and a clear conference mission that establishes farmers as leaders and incorporates food justice principles.

Growth & Change

In response to what we heard from farmers, we are excited to announce new and exciting changes this year.

- **Stronger Farmer Voice:** For the first time, the conference is guided by our newly created Farmer Advisory Committee that advises the Planning Committee on the direction of the conference! Made up of 10 emerging farmers, this committee centers more farmer voices in decision-making for the conference.
- **Increased Outreach:** Last fall, we hired a fulltime Outreach Coordinator who is entirely dedicated to planning the Emerging Farmer's Conference, leading outreach for the event, and incorporating listening session findings.
- **Time to Connect:** We will be working to create more intentional spaces for one-on-one interactions between farmers and sponsors at the conference.

Conference Details: New Era, New Location

Day one of the conference will be hosted at the Shoreview Community Center and features engaging sessions that are rich with discussion, storytelling and physical movement! Day two of the conference will be a field day where farmers and attendees will have opportunities for on-farm learning. This year's field day will enrich the experience by allowing farmers to learn hands-on and engage with community outside of the conference room.
